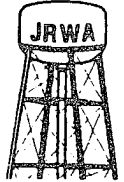


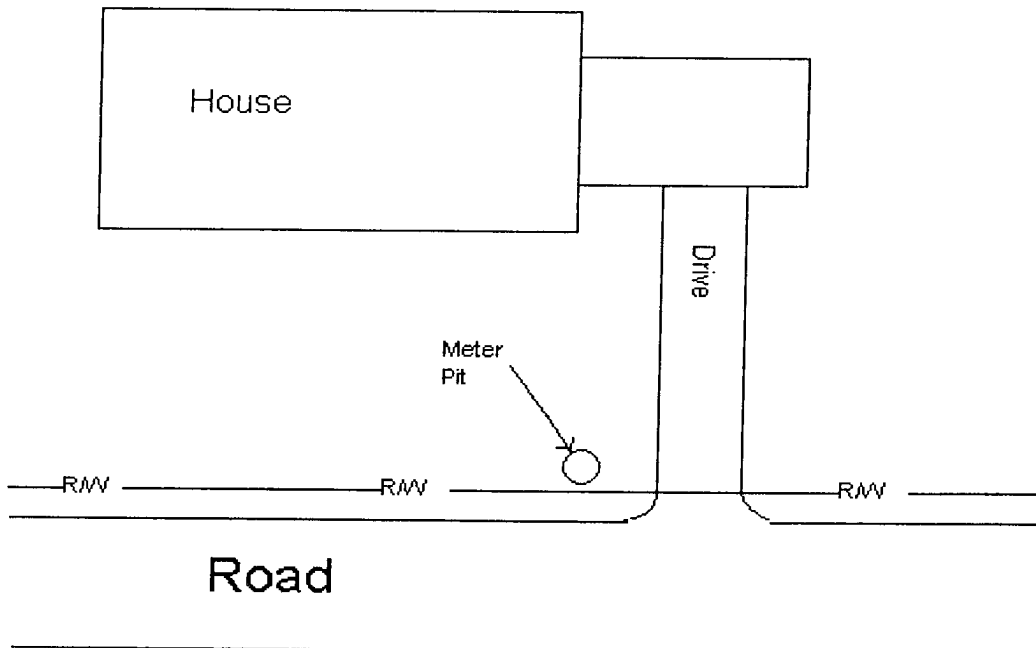

METER PIT LOCATION AND DETAILS

1. All paper work must be on file and tap fees paid before JRWA will perform the service installation.
2. JRWA will make all meter pit installations. This service is included for the cost of the tap fee.
3. There is no additional cost if the water main is on the opposite side of the street from the property to be served.
4. It is the owner's responsibility to have the service line installed from the meter pit to the house.
5. All service lines installed by the owner or the owner's contractor must be inspected by Montgomery County Combined Health District.
6. Meter pits will be located as close to the road and driveway as possible. All meter pits will be located outside of the road right-of-way (R/W).
7. **The water meter will not be set at the time of the meter pit installation. The property owner must call the JRWA water office to request that the meter be set. Once meter is set, owner will begin receiving the water bill.**



1. JRWA's responsibility will stop immediately after the meter pit. It is the owner's responsibility to repair leaks and perform other maintenance between the house and the meter pit.
2. Service lines are required to be buried at least 42-inches deep. Montgomery County Combined Health District will verify proper service line depth at the time of their inspection. (Do not backfill pipe before inspection)
3. All owner's are required to have a shut off valve and pressure reducing valve installed on the service line after it enters the structure to be serviced.
4. JRWA requires 1-inch copper tube size (CTS) service line to be used by the owner. If Polyethylene tubing is used, 200 PSI grade tubing is required. If the owner chooses to use copper, then K-type roll copper is required. Indoor, sweat copper will not be accepted.
5. Meter pits and curb boxes must be accessible at all times. No physical obstruction to the meter pit and curb box will be allowed.
